

COGE report to UCC
February 17, 2021

Ongoing activities:

1. The faculty survey of General Education is complete. COGE has discussed preliminary results in January, and now is waiting for qualitative and quantitative analysis from members tasked with the sorting the data. COGE meets February 24th for further discussion of Faculty Survey data.
2. COGE has drafted a student survey of General Education and will be deploying it in March.
3. The Teagle Foundation/NEH has decided not invite RIC to submit a formal grant proposal for their Gen Ed renewal grant.
4. COGE is pilot of assessment of English 120 is complete. There are seventeen sections of English 120 running this term. The Provost is currently working to identify a faculty member willing to take on Assessment tasks so that we can produce an assessment of General Education this semester following a version of the URI model.
5. The chair of COGE met with his counterparts from CCRI and URI. Further discussions are planned. CCRI will come to COGE in March to discuss the progress they have made in revising their general education program.
6. The COGE website now has all eleven learning outcomes rubrics posted along with the chart that maps outcomes to courses. Previous General Education assessment reports and now live on the RIC Gen Ed site.
7. The Provost has asked the chair of COGE to help her produce an application to the AAC&U's summer institute on General Education. June 8-11 and assemble a team.
8. COGE's discussion of the Second Language requirement is ongoing. Holly Shadoian will join COGE at this month's meeting for this discussion.
